PCC Treasury Report – Dave Soohoo

- Monthly: 3 financial statements sent to EC.

Session Update - Sept. 14 Meeting

- 8 members of the Mandarin Commission resigned. Session accepted resignations.
- 2 New Elders elected to the MC: Mandy Liang and Paul Xiao Fei Li
- Conflict unresolved; The Mandarin Commission (MC) did not provide additional context on
 whether the departure of their elders signaled how the remaining members of the Mandarin
 Worshiping Community view the theological differences around LGBTQ+ inclusion and
 accepting Don as a pastor. This left the English Commission (EC) wanting more clarity. The
 upcoming compassion communication training may help create space for deeper and more
 reciprocal dialogue.
- EC will give the MC space to process the changes. The plan is to continue with the discernment process.

This is all the information EC has at this time. We are committed to transparency and will update the EWC as soon as possible.
