A Summary of the November 2023 English Commission Meeting

Committee and Other Reports

- 1. San Francisco Presbytery
 - a. Leadership Model Task Force Recommendations of the task force were approved. A presbytery nominating committee will be formed to conduct a search for an Interim Presbyter. The current transitional leadership team will continue in their roles until their contracts expire in May 2024.
 - b. The presbytery approved unanimously Rev. Don Hammond's call from an interim to Designated called position for the English congregation of the Presbyterian Church in Chinatown effective January 1, 2024. On behalf of the DPNC and PCC, Heidi Wong spoke in favor of the motion.
- 2. Mission and Evangelism
 - a. Food Pantry
 - 1) Enrollment 15 new participants transferred from the Food Bank's discontinued Pantry at Home program. About 10 more participants will be added in future weeks to bring enrollment to 315.
 - 2) Calendar
 - a) November 18 The pantry was closed because of logistical problems associated with the APEC conference.
 - b) Re-registration of clients will begin in December.
 - c) The City's required satisfaction survey will be distributed in February and due in March.
 - b. Christmas Joy Offering This special offering is a way to honor God's gift of Jesus Christ by helping current and retired church workers in their time of need and developing our future leaders at Presbyterian-related schools and colleges equipping communities of color. The offering will be accepted through Sunday, December 24, 2023.

- 5. PCC/CH Partnership

Pastor Don met with the Interim Executive Director, Dr. Bhupendra Sheoran. The interim appointment is part-time temporary for a period of 6-8 months.

- 6. Board of Deacons
 - a. Retreat In October, Rev. Henry Wong, hospital chaplain, led a two-hour session on visiting the ill or hospitalized, as well as helped to explain why Chinese are so reluctant to discuss illness. Evaluation of the retreat was very positive and valuable.
 - b. Christmas Gift to Food Pantry Clients The deacons are pooling their resources with the Food Pantry to give clients a gift of oyster sauce for Christmas. Each bottle will be labeled with messages that read "Merry Christmas and Happy New Year" and "We invite you to worship and fellowship with us" in English and Chinese.
- 7. Pastor's Report

Pastor Don will be officiating Communion in the Cantonese worship service on Sunday December 10th. Elder Eleanor Wong has also asked him to moderate the Cantonese Commission meeting that day. Currently, the Cantonese Commission is without an authorized PC(USA) Celebrant for Communion and a Moderator for their Commission.

- 8. Treasurer's Report
 - a. Budget Notes
 - A portion of our reserves was used to purchase two certificates of deposit (CDs). The CDs will mature in January and October 2024 and yield interest of \$3,200 and \$5,000 respectively. Upon maturity, the funds will be rolled over and reinvested in new CDs.

- f. Hybrid Meetings in the Fellowship Hall Building & Finance will be discussing how to improve technology and user experience of hybrid meetings in the fellowship hall.

 - a. To Do: Pastor Don will poll the elders to identify a Saturday or Sunday in January-February to hold a special service of worship and celebration.

 - a. The Commission acknowledged and appreciated the extensive work done by Kevin Feeley to identify and research an unmet need in Chinatown and propose a strategy to fill an educational need of students in Chinatown when the Chinatown branch of the library is closed for renovation in spring 2024.
