Praise to our Lord, the Cantonese Worshiping Community had a wonderful summer this year. We would like to share with you the two big events – Evangelism “Jesus Loves Chinatown” and our Annual Cantonese Congregational Retreat.

The fifth evangelism event “Jesus Loves Chinatown”, partnered with Christian Short-Term Mission Training Center and ten other Christian churches in the Bay Area, was held from July 23rd to 28th. Full and part time evangelism training and outreach were provided for those six days. Five members of the Cantonese group participated. We also hosted one of the closing events in our church on Saturday, July 28th which was called “Wonderful Music – Faith, Hope and Love”, the music evangelism program held by our choir. They had been preparing and rehearsing for a couple months.
